

## Ways to help with Missions (all year round)

1. Recycle aluminum cans in shed at FUMC behind old kitchen (funds go to local Habitat).
2. Recycle used printer cartridges in postage-paid mailers in FUMC narthex or office (funds go to local Habitat).
3. Recycle cardboard boxes, paper and plastic grocery bags to FUMC fellowship hall (for Foodbank pantry).
4. Bring non-perishable food items to Foodbank barrel in FUMC narthex ( for Foodbank pantry).
5. Recycle clean used clothing and linens in tubs in FUMC narthex (items go to Casa Esperanza thrift shop for Hispanic Ministries).
6. Put spare change in acrylic box in FUMC narthex (funds go to Northampton Social Ministries for emergency assistance to Northampton residents).
7. Recycle Fresh Pride receipts, Campbell's product labels and General Mills coupons in box in FUMC narthex ((UMW collection for funds for school assistance).
8. Register MVP card at Food Lion (for rebate to FUMC Youth for missions projects).
9. Be a volunteer driver for Shore Cancer Center patients (contact Sam Belote at American Cancer Society).
10. Make a special offering for FUMC Agape Fund in baskets in our sanctuary at worship services on first Sunday of each month (for emergency assistance for local needs).
11. Knit or crochet a prayer shawl or make a donation for yarn (shawls given to ill or bereaved members of FUMC community – contact Faye Sandsbury for information).
12. Stock up on items on sale for Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes, back-to-school backpacks, mini health kits for migrants and Kits for Conference all year long.
13. Volunteer for two hours (weekly, monthly or just one time) at Foodbank Thrift Shop in Tasley, Casa Esperanza Thrift Shop, or Lighthouse Ministries in Keller.
14. Volunteer for two hours monthly to unload Foodbank truck, pack boxes or help on food distribution day (third Friday of each month) for FUMC Foodbank pantry. Contact Susie Jones, Patsy Stith or Rev. Alex Joyner for specific times.
15. Volunteer to take the trash from packing Foodbank boxes to a dumpster or trash collection site or burn pile – one pick-up load once a month!
16. Volunteer at local Habitat home sites, weekly, monthly or just one time. Get a group together for a day. Local volunteers work every Monday, Thursday and Saturday. Contact Habitat office in Exmore (442-HOUS) for current work location.
17. Write a letter or e-mail to FUMC's sponsored missionary in the Congo, Jacques Akasa.
18. Write a monthly letter or e-mail to the children and staff at Chentsy and Petrovsky orphanages in Russia, whether you are a sponsor or not. Put letters in the basket in FUMC narthex or give to Linda Ennis. Nothing means more to the children than having mail.
19. Pray for all of the mission projects of Franktown church.
